You must also respect the criteria of the blog carnival hosts by submitting your blog trackbacks only to blog carnivals that are relevant to your posts..

XinglaPro is not to be used as a tool for spamming irrelevant blog posts across the list of carnivals. The only thing that this will accomplish is getting yourself banned from the blog carnivals. Blog carnival hosts screen all submissions before accepting them.

Xingla Pro 4 Help

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Xingla Pro Overview

Xingla Pro is an automatic submission tool to take the time consuming element out of the blog carnival procedure. Xingla Pro is designed to give you complete flexibility in building your custom lists so that you can keep your lists as relevant as possible to your blog post categories.

With Xingla Pro you can quickly build lists using the 'Search Filter' feature, under the “Create a New List” tab. A complete list of all the available blog carnivals is populated when you start Xingla Pro.

After building your list you can automatically submit your Blog posts in just seconds. Your lists can then be saved for future use.

Submitting to blog carnivals is one of the most effective methods of building large volumes of back links to your website and increasing traffic. As a result, you will experience significantly increased search engine ranking and revenue from your blog.

Using Xingla Pro

After installing Xingla Pro for the first time, you will see a login screen the first time you launch Xingla Pro. Simply provide the username and password that you created during the checkout process when you purchased and Xingla Pro. These are the same credentials that you used when you downloaded Xingla Pro.

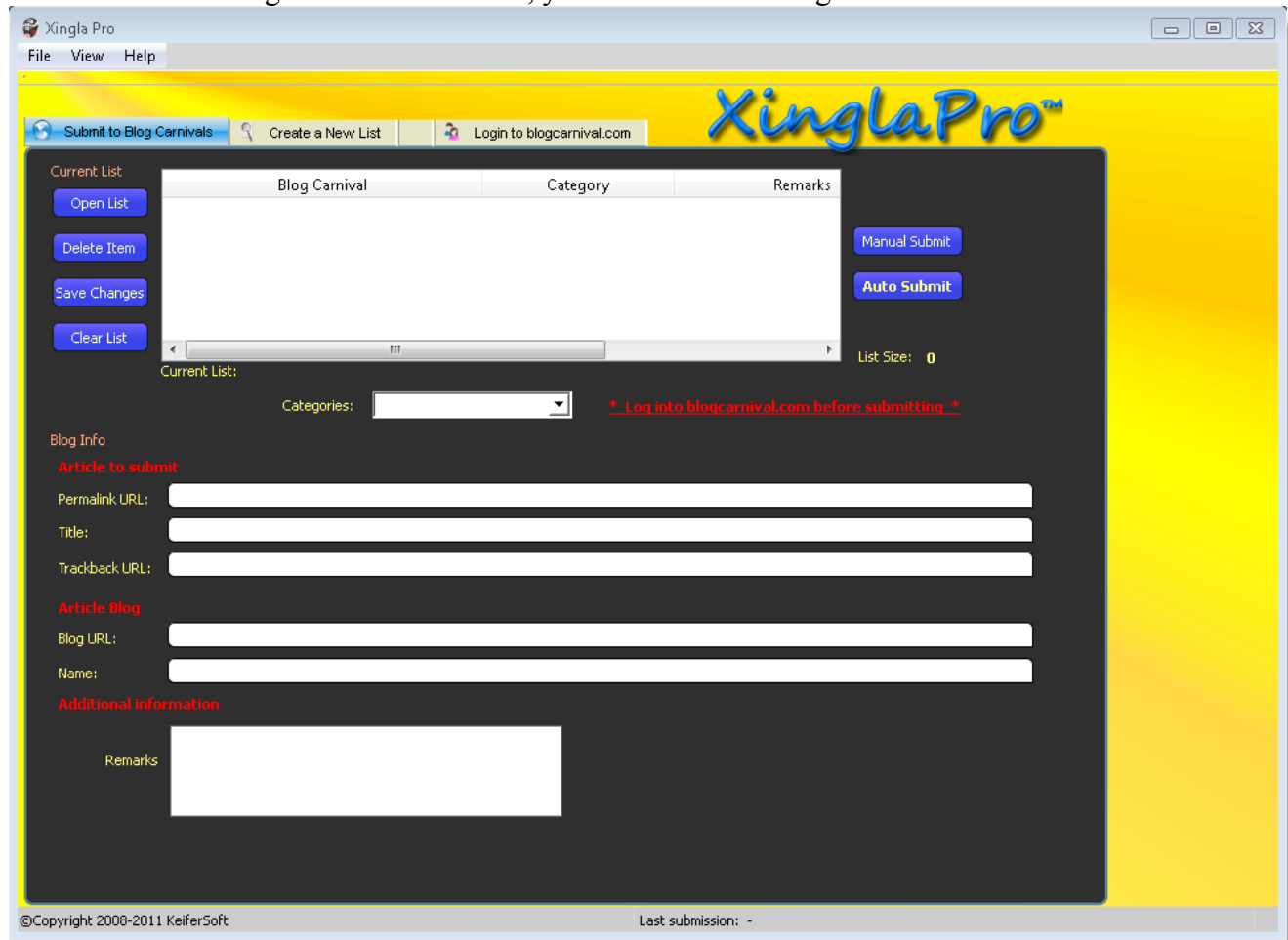


To avoid having to log in every time you use Xingla Pro, leave the “Remember my info” check-box checked. It is checked by default.

After a successful log-in for the first time, you will see something similar to this:



Log into blogcarnival.com from Xingla Pro

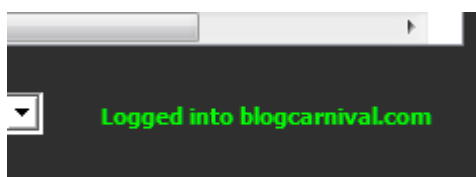
The next thing you want to do is to click the “**Login to blogcarnival.com**” tab. You need a free blogcarnival.com account in order to submit your posts reliably. If you don't have an account, click on the “*Register with blogcarnival.com*” link below the **Login** button to get a free account.


Enter your email address and password info for your **blogcarnival.com** account.

Leave the “*Save my login info*” check-box checked to automatically log in each time you start Xingla Pro.

Click the **Login** button. Once logged in, you will be switched back to the main submission area in Xingla Pro (1st tab), and you will now see that you are logged in as shown below:

If you are launching Xingla Pro for the first time, your list will be blank. Naturally the next step is to create a new list. This can be done quickly with the help of Xingla Pro's Search filter.

By clicking the next tab over (**Create a New List**), you can add new blog carnivals to your list by selecting the carnivals from the list area, and dragging them over to your new list on the left.

Building a New Carnival List

To create a new blog carnival list, click on the “**Create a New List**” tab.

When building a new list, be sure that all the blog carnivals that you select are relevant to one category. For example, if you want to build a list relating to self-improvement, then only select carnivals related to “Self Improvement”.

To start building a new list, simply select the blog carnivals from the right-hand list, and drag them over to the left-hand list.

If you have many items in your new list (left-hand side), it isn't necessary to scroll down to the bottom to add items. You can simply continue to drag items over, but **you must drop them in-between the rows**.

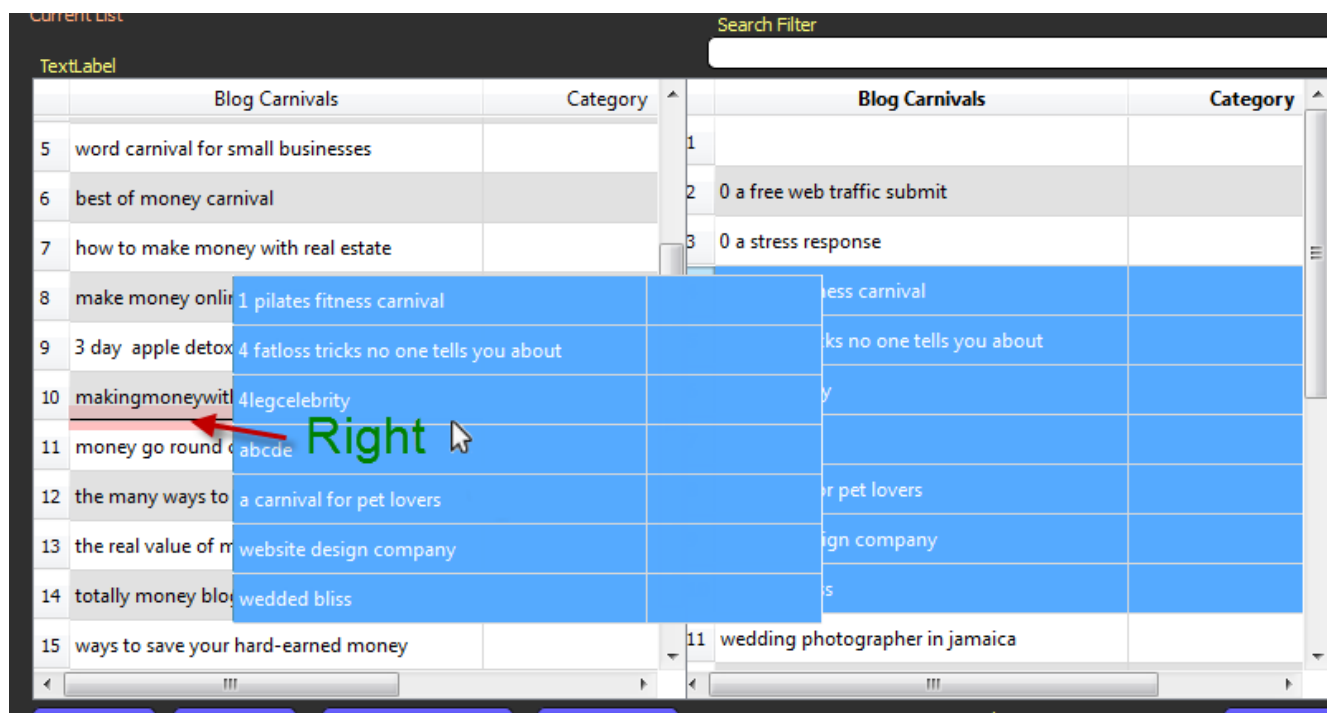
If you highlight a row when dropping new items, the highlighted row will be overwritten.

Here are illustrations of the wrong way, and then the right way to drag into a crowded list:

As shown above, if you drag your selected items over an existing row, that row will be overwritten.

The correct method is to drag items in-between the rows as shown below:



Use The Search Filter For Ultra Fast List Building!

You can instantly narrow your listings by keywords, by typing them in the Search Filter field above the Carnival listings, and pressing **Enter**.

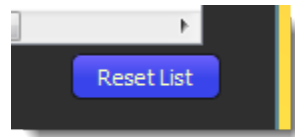


In this example, we did a search for blog carnivals with the keyword 'marketing'. 5 results were returned.. Now we simply select the carnivals that we want to add to our list and drag them over to the adjacent table on the left.

Simply repeat the steps with additional related keywords to build a quick list.

To reveal all the remaining carnivals again, simply clear the Search Filter field and press **Enter**.

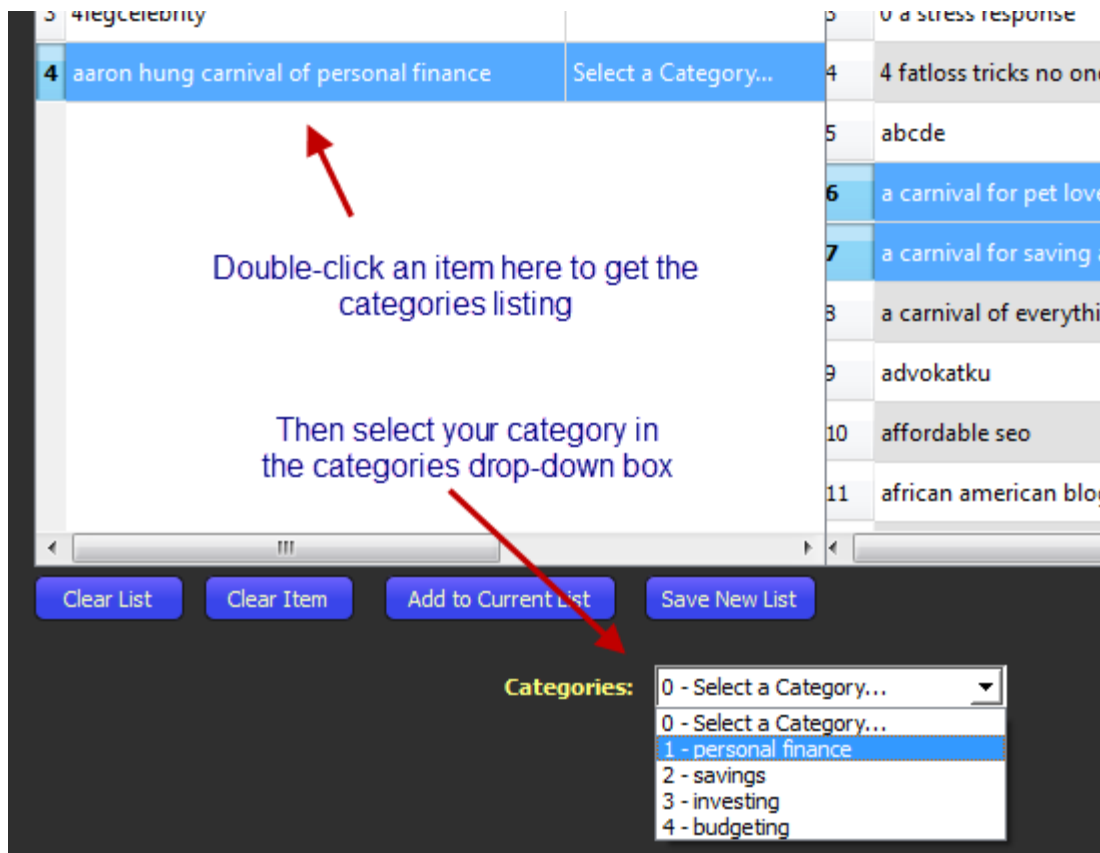
If you want to start over, and display all of the carnival listings again (including the ones you moved out), you can click the “**Reset List**” button to refresh the complete listings of all available carnivals.



Add Categories & Get Carnival Information

If categories exist for your carnivals, you can add them to your carnival listing by double-clicking the carnival in your list. You will then see your “Categories” drop down box display “**Select a Category**” as the first item. Select the category of your choice. It will be instantly updated in your list.

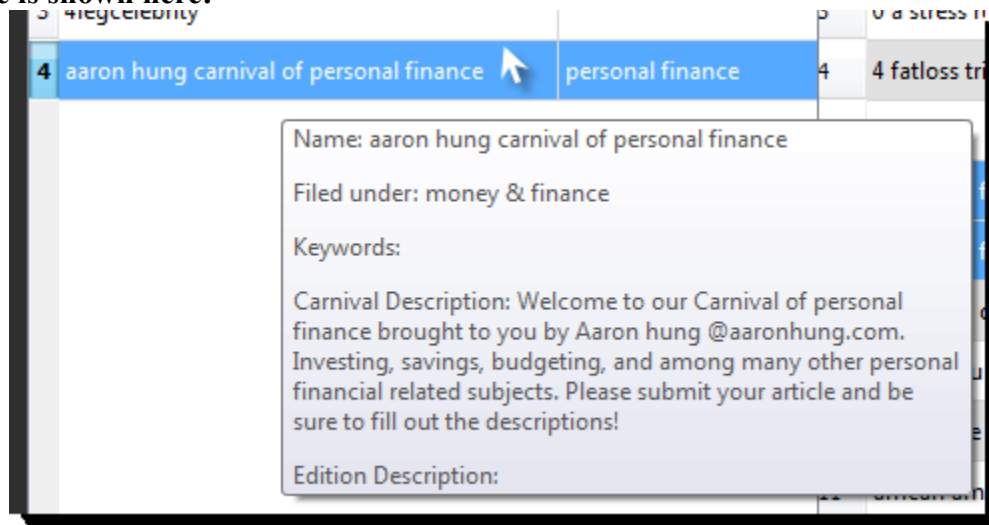
Repeat the process for any carnival that you wish to include a category for. You can perform this step in any of the tables which contain listings.



Get Carnival Information

After double-clicking an item Xingla Pro will also grab the carnival info for that listing. The info will appear as a tool-tip. To trigger the tool-tip, simply move your mouse over the carnival listing that you double-clicked.

An example is shown here:



You can use this information to keep your lists accurate so that your submissions are relevant to the blog carnival. As a result, you will have a higher acceptance rate for your submissions. Thus, you can avoid irritating the blog carnival owner with non-relevant submissions.

Saving your new list

Once your list is created, click on the **Save new list** button and give your file name something relevant so that it's easy to refer to.

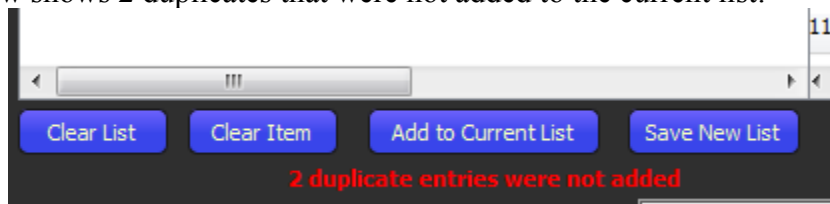
Add to Current List

You can add to an existing list which is open in your main "Submit to blog carnivals" area by clicking the "Add to Current List" button. All items in the list will be moved to your current list.

Duplicate Entries

When adding to an existing list, Xingla Pro will automatically weed out any carnivals that already exist on your current list.

The example below shows 2 duplicates that were not added to the current list:



Clear Item

By clicking the “Clear Item” button, you will remove the selected carnival from the list.

Clear List

Selecting this button will clear the entire list.

Automatically Keep Your Lists Current With The Automatic 'Check Inactives' Feature

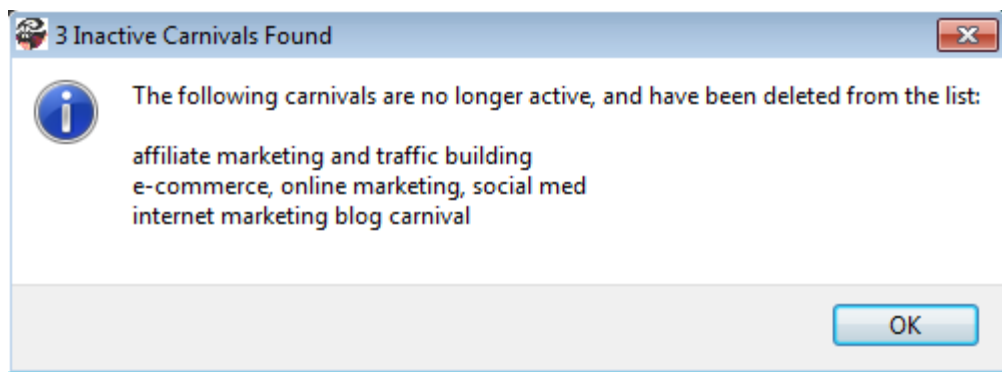
Over time, some of the blog carnivals in your list will become inactive. This is normally because some blog carnival hosts will stop participating in the blog carnivals for one reason or another. Perhaps because they are back-logged with submissions and need a break.

These inactive listings will make your actual list smaller than it appears. For example, you may have 30 carnivals in your list and a month later, only 25 are active. When you auto-submit your posts to that list, you'll be expecting to get 30 submissions, when in reality you will only be submitting to 25.

Every time you start Xingla Pro, your most recent list will be loaded, and Xingla will check your list for any inactive carnivals. This happens in the background each time a list is opened.

When extinct carnivals are detected, a dialog box will display the inactive carnivals and inform you that they have been deleted from your list.

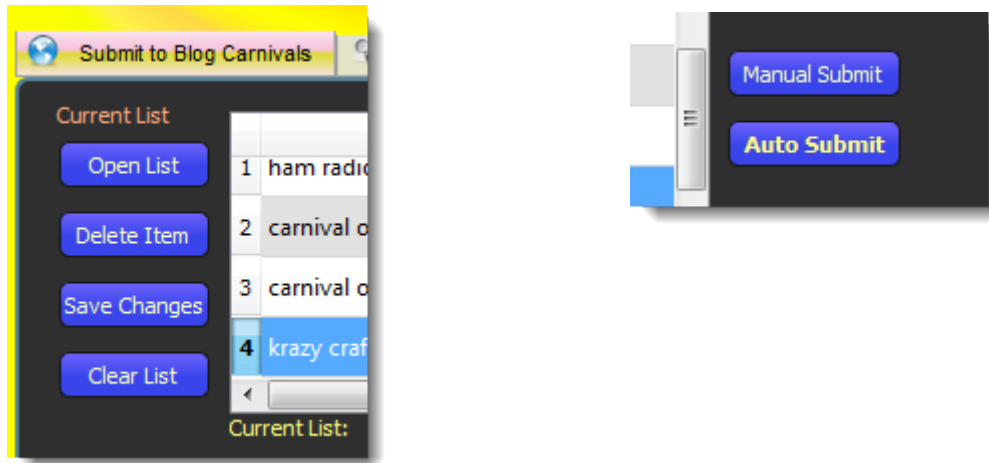
Here is a screen shot of the results from an old list which contained some inactive carnivals:



The Main Blog Carnival Submission Area

Carnival List Buttons

Here is an overview of the left hand list buttons as illustrated below:



Open List

Click to open an existing list which has been previously created.

Delete Item

Delete an item in your list.

Save Changes

Save any that you have made to your current list, such as a category change, or adding remarks.

Clear List

This will clear your entire list. You will be prompted as to whether you really want to clear the list. If you click yes, your entire list will be cleared. This is convenient if you wish to start your list over with all new entries from the list builder.

Manual Submit

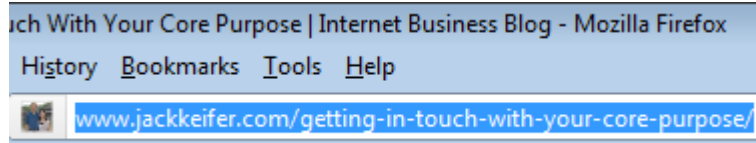
Submit your post one at a time to the selected item in your list.

Auto-Submit


Automatically submit your posts to all the carnivals in your list. You can abort the auto-submission process by clicking the button again. Auto-submit your post after filling in the Blog Carnival Form.

Filling in The Blog Carnival Form

Before submitting a blog post, you need to add the permalink to the **Permalink URL** field. A permalink is the URL of the blog post that you wish to submit. Simply navigate to your blog post within your web browser, and copy the URL from the address bar.




3. Blog Carnival Submission Fields

Copy the Permalink URL from your blog post and paste it into the **Permalink URL** field as shown above. Click into the next field and let Xingla Pro update the other fields for you.

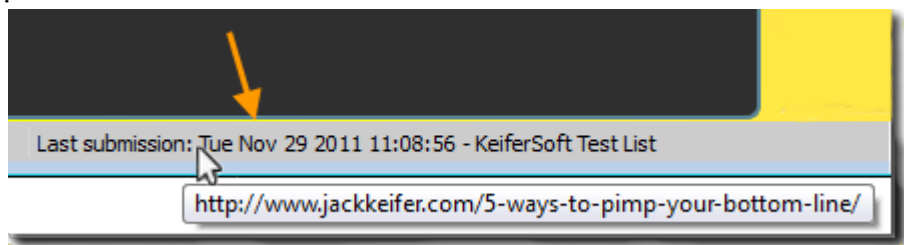
After the fields are updated, you will get a result similar to the screen pic below:

Now click the “Auto Submit” button (or press Enter), and Xingla Pro will automatically submit to all the blog carnivals in your list. **It's that easy!**

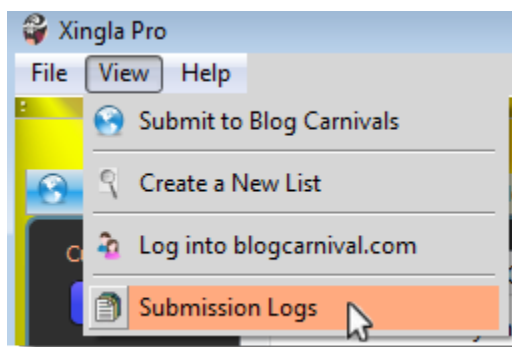
Last Submission Date and Time

As of version 4 of Xingla Pro, you can now see the Date and time of your last blog submission, plus the name of the list that was used in the submission. When you mouse over the information, you will also see the permalink for that submission. It is located in the right-hand side of the task-bar at the bottom as shown below:




Previous Submission Logs

You can view a history of your previous blog carnival submissions by clicking on the *View* menu, and then selecting "Submission Logs".



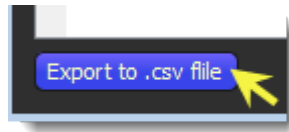

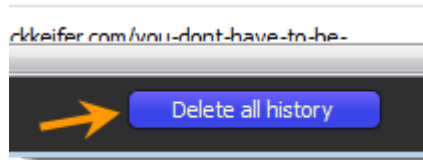

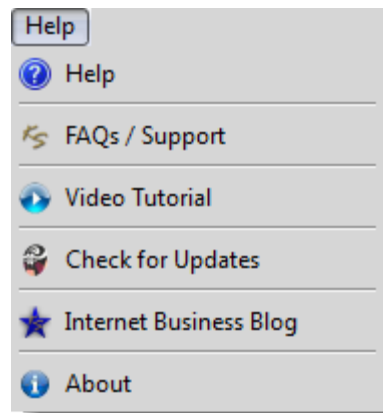
If you wish to archive your history, you can select the “**Export to .csv file**” button to save a copy of your history to your hard drive.



If you want to permanently clear all your history from your submissions list, select the “**Delete all history**” button.

This will open the 'About' box for Xingla Pro.



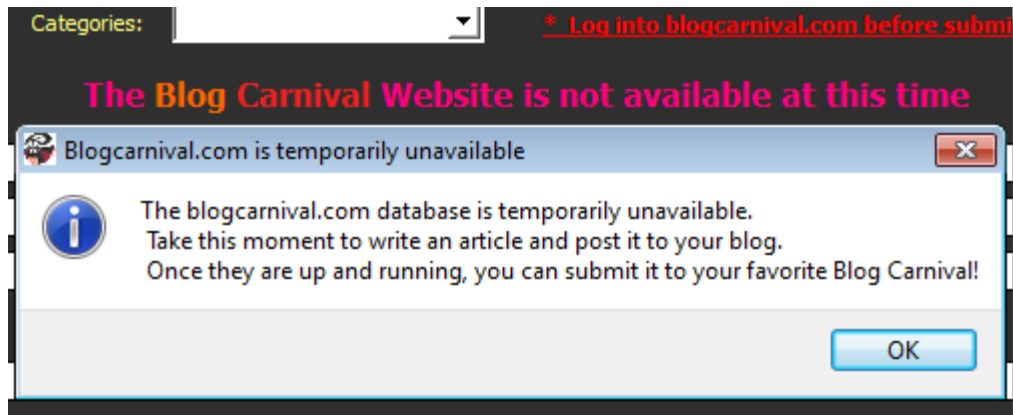
Here, you can check the current version of Xingla Pro. This is handy for verifying that you have the latest version after an automatic update has been run.

FAQ's

Error Messages related to blogcarnival.com

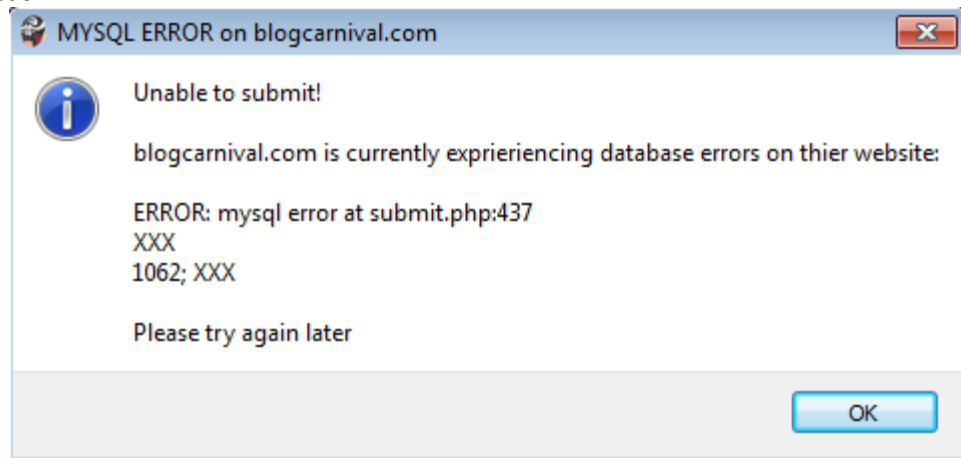
If blogcarnival.com is unavailable, or has database issues, Xingla pro will return a related Error message.

Here are screen shots related to typical issues that could arise:



The above message indicates that blogcarnival.com is having issues with their database, and is unable to load the home page, or the submit page at <http://blogcarnival.com/bc/submit.php>

Since the website is not available, your status will also indicate that you are not logged into blogcarnival.com



The above message is typical when you're trying to submit a blog post during a time when blogcarnival.com is experiencing database problems, and is unable to process your submissions.

In either of the above cases, all you can do is wait until the problem is resolved on their website, and then try again.

Downtime is typically uncommon, but it can happen from time to time.

I haven't been receiving email receipts after submitting my blog carnivals. What's up?

This is not something related to Xingla Pro. As of the time of this writing, it seems that blogcarnival.com is not sending receipts for blog submissions. This is the case whether you submit using Xingla Pro, or submit directly from their website.
